



## Loveland High School Sports Medicine

Loveland High School Athletics is committed to providing our athletes with the finest sports medicine support available. Our relationship with University Orthopaedics & Sports Medicine and NovaCare Rehabilitation is structured to ensure Loveland athletes receive state of the art medical support in terms of prevention, diagnosis, treatment and rehabilitation. Below are basic policies and procedures of the Loveland Athletic Training Staff:

1. The Loveland High School Sports Medicine Department is responsible for the prevention, evaluation, treatment and rehabilitation of athletic injuries suffered by student athletes participating in sports sponsored by the Loveland Athletic Department.
2. Services can be obtained during posted Athletic Training Room hours. These hours are posted on the Athletic Training Room door and may vary by season.
3. All services are rendered at the discretion the athletic training staff based on staff knowledge and experience and at the direction of a licensed physician or physical therapist.
4. **Any time a student-athletes sees a physician, he/she must return a note to the athletic training staff indicating any treatment and rehabilitation to be given and playing status.** No treatment and rehabilitation will be given nor will the student-athlete be allowed to participate without a note.
5. During acute situations such as practices and home contest, the athletic staff will determine participation status with input from the student-athlete, coaching staff and parents/guardians.
6. Student-athletes are highly encouraged to see a staff athletic trainer whenever an injury is suspected. What may seem to be a minor injury can quickly turn into a significant injury if left untreated.
7. Student-athletes are responsible for informing coaches of their location if missing practice or game time to receive service.
